

Gila River Telecommunications, Inc. Affordable Connectivity Program

The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) is a Federal Communications Commission (FCC) program that replaces the Emergency Broadband Benefit Program (EBB) to help low-income households pay for Internet service and connected devices.



If your household is qualified, you can receive

Tribal Benefit - Up to a \$75/month discount

Device Discount - A one-time discount of \$100 towards a GRTI laptop

How do I qualify for the program?

- Your household income is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.
- Participate in an assistance program, such as SNAP, Medicaid, SSI, or Lifeline, etc.
- Participate in one of several Tribal specific programs.
- Approved to receive benefits under the free and reduced price school lunch program or the school breakfast program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision in the 2019-2020, 2020-2021 or 2021-22 school year.
- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year
- Receive special supplemental Nutrition Program for women, infant, and children (WIC) assistance.
